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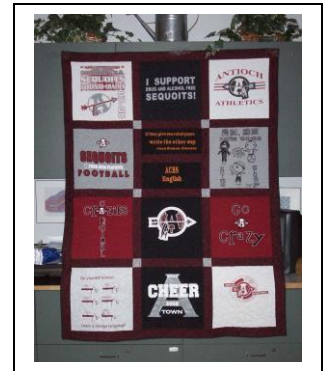

Exposure to Studio 180 Design Tools

Learn how to improve the precision of making basic units for any pattern by using the Studio 180 Design tools. The concept is to make the basic unit slightly oversized so that you can trim it to the exact measurements you need without losing any points. You will want to use these techniques on any pattern you purchase. As you progress into the advanced tools, you will quickly find yourself designing your own blocks.

Making Hunter's Star Blocks Using the Rapid Fire Hunter's Star Tool

Master the traditional Hunter's Star unit with a simple technique. Have your points turn out crisp and clean using the Rapid Fire Hunter's Star tool from Studio 180 Design. You will quickly become addicted with the endless possibilities and layouts that this block has to offer. This is an intermediate level technique.



What's the Point?

Make your Lemoyne stars twinkle by using the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star tool from Studio 180 Design. Stop cutting out odd shapes with angles that never quite match up and eliminate those bulky center spots where multiple seams intersect. You will be able to make a block as small as 3" with the same precision as a 12" block. This is an advanced level technique.
